Project scope:

This project is one of the Lima City School District building projects. The school was originally named Washington-McKinley Elementary School and has been changed to "Freedom Elementary School."

This new one-story 59,469 square foot K-4 facility was built to house a student capacity of 354. The exterior of the building consists of masonry bearing walls with brick veneer, a bright blue standing seam metal roof and architectural aluminum doors and windows. The interior is a concrete slab-on-grade first floor, with painted masonry block walls, carpet / vinyl tile floor coverings, and ceramic tile restrooms. The school features air conditioning, a kitchen, cafeteria with a separate gymnasium, and state-of-the-art security and technology.
