Project scope:

This project is one of the Lima City School District building projects. The school was originally named Westwood Elementary School and has been changed to "Lima West Middle School."

This new two-story middle school facility of 70,224 square feet was built to house a student capacity of 490. The exterior is made of a steel frame and masonry bearing walls with brick veneer, a green metal shingle roof and architectural aluminum doors and windows. The interior is a concrete slab-on-grade first floor and bar joist supported concrete second floor, with painted masonry block walls, carpet and vinyl tile floor coverings, and ceramic tile restrooms. The school features a kitchen, cafeteria, gymnasium, air conditioning, computer lab, as well as state-of-the-art security and technology.
